For Full Training Programs a discount of \$25 if payment is made in full on or before the first of the month. No refunds. No rollover for weekly lessons.

LESSONS

All lessons must be scheduled with CLTC prior to desired lesson day. Please give 24 hours notice of any CANCELLATION otherwise you will be charged for the missed lesson. All lessons are Private or Semi-Private unless otherwise agreed upon with CLTC. Grooming and tacking is included in your lesson hour until you are proficient to do so on your own, at that point your Private lessons are no more than 30 minutes and Semi -Privates are 1 hour - please arrive early to tack up your horse. SHOW CHARGES

Entry Fees, Show Charges and Hauling Fees are due and payable upon receipt of invoice. These fees must be paid in-full prior to the horse's departure for a show. Horse show hauling fees will be added unless prior arrangements have been made.

Other charges such as extra feed, bedding, vet/medications will be charged on an as needed basis after the show.

*Discount rate available for multiple horses at same show. Some expenses (extra feed, hotel charges for trainer/groom) will be pro-rated per horse attending show. Horse show charges DO NOT INCLUDE Entry Fees, Tack Stalls, Groom Stalls, Shavings, Premium/Special Stabling, Early Arrivals, Layover Charges, Box Seats, or Patron Packages. Patronships and/or Premium Stabling costs will be prorated among the total number of horses attending a show.

FEE EXPLANATIONS AND IMPORTANT INFORMATION

If multiple riders per horse Add \$100 for a Class A Show and \$200 for Regional/National Shows then all costs will be split amongst parties. This is to accommodate the additional lessons and show classes.

If multiple riders are leasing one horse in Full Training - the fees are split equally amongst the lessors/owners. The 2 lesson rule per week still applies and any additional lessons are \$25/lesson.

If Less than 6 Horses attend Nationals or Regionals then Hotel Expenses and any Special Decorations will be Pro-Rated amongst horses attending show.

Full Training includes 2 lessons per week. Part time training includes up to 1 lesson per week. Additional lessons are \$25 each.

CLTC requires a 30 day WRITTEN notice prior to release of clients horse, or next month's fees are fully earned. All unpaid fees must be paid in full in CASH or CASHIER'S CHECK.

Estimated show fees will be billed in advance and are due prior to departure of the show. Any additional costs after the show will be billed and are due upon receipt (ie. shavings, feed, medications).

All Farrier fees are due upon receipt.

Vaccinations and De-Worming are billed directly to client.

Any equipment borrowed by CLTC that is destroyed by client or their horse must be replaced. You are welcome to purchase your own equipment and please mark it clearly with your name.
